Karin and I wanted to wish each and everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year as we approach this Holiday Season. You folks are our family and friends. We realize that without you we could not reach our Military for Christ. Thank you once again for your love of missions and missionaries.

Blessings - We would like to report that two more people were gloriously saved since our last letter. We also were able to see some surrender to full time service. We have the joy of going out and helping churches visit while being on the road. We thank the Lord for working in the hearts of people.

Opportunities - We will be leaving March 26 to fill in for Karin's parents in Canada for 45 days, and then we will be leaving back to Germany from Canada in the middle of May to work alongside a fellow BIMI missionary as we watch as the military makes its announced base closures and realignments in Europe. We will be looking for new opportunities to minister as these bases open up around the world. We are homesick and looking forward to getting back.

Support - We are at 90% to return to the field . We are trusting the Lord to use the churches that we have been at and our remaining meetings to bring in the needed funds. The dollar to the euro is still low. We see the need to have the proper support to be able to help carry a ministry and to take care of our personal needs. Europe has a very high cost of living for rent, fuel and food. Our pastor would like us to be at 100% before our departure. We thank the Lord for safety as we have reported to our supporting churches and have visited 90 new churches and have traveled over 75,000 miles. The vehicle we are using now has over 140,000 miles on it. We have meetings up through the time of our departure. We praise the Lord for new churches adding us on for financial support.

Passage - We thank the Lord for a special gift this past month that was given on our return passage fund. We must purchase tickets, vehicle, rent an apartment, and buy furniture on the field. We are saving personally and using special love gifts to build this fund up so we can try to make a debt free transition back to the field. We currently have \$4,700. We are starting over as we arrive back. I have a desire to provide for Karin as she made such a sacrifice to live in the church building on our first term. We are very appreciative of any help you could provide in this area. Special gifts can be marked Pierce Passage Fund.

Friends - We are so thankful for all the new friends we have met since being back. They have been such an encouragement to us in many ways.

Soldiers - Please keep our military in prayer as we have now lost over 2052 soldiers. We desire to make a difference in these young people's hearts.
